

LEAGUES 2014

1. The host club is responsible for organizing and running the shoot as well as obtaining and presenting mementos or certificates if applicable. Host clubs should market their shoot and ensure that entry forms are available to clubs/shooters at their earliest convenience. The nature of prizes presented, if any, is at the discretion of the host club.
2. Entry fees are not more than R25.00 per event and R20.00 range fee. A levy of R5.00 per shooter per event must be paid to the shooter's Province by the host club.
3. Scores shot will count towards the individual league. All shooters must be a member of a Club, affiliated to WPPA, WCPA or CPPA to participate in leagues.
4. Scores shot at the SAPA Open Nationals and WPPA Championships will count towards individual leagues.

6. TARGETS

50 Yards	1 sighter and 3 counting targets	10 shots must be shot per target
Std Pistol	1 sighter and 3 counting targets	20 shots must be shot per target
25 M Pistol/CF	1 sighter and 3 counting targets	10 shots must be shot per target

50 M Pistol	1 sighter and 4 counting targets	15 shots must be shot per target

7. Competitors must supply their own pegs for use at League-, Provincial- and National shoots.
8. Starting times of details may change and competitors must ensure they are timeously entered with the Host Club for the shoot.
9. For postal league shoots, check with your own club to confirm starting times which may differ from club to club, according to range facilities.
10. Patched targets may be used as sighters.
11. Competitors must be on the range 15 minutes before starting time.
12. PPC. When shooting 1500, your score from Match 5 may be used as a Distinguished Pistol or Revolver score, if you wish.
